## Literacy

**Writing-** Vocabulary focus— **VCOP** writing including, wow words, connectives and openers.

**Reading-** Reading strategies including predicting, connecting and comparing. Our class novel, *Charlotte's Web* will include opportunities to develop reading, writing and cross curricular skills within our first few weeks in class.

**Talking and Listening-** The children will present a short personal talk on a subject of their choice, suitable for school.

## Numeracy

**Squares P5—** Our focus this term will be revision of tables facts, multiples and factors, place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

**Rectangles P4—** This group will be working on learning our tables facts, multiplication and division with remainders. Place value with numbers to 1000 will also be our main focus for term one.

**Circles P4/5—** Miss Pinkerton will work with this group on a daily basis. She will be focussing on number bonds to 100, halving numbers and mental maths strategies.

As a class we will be continually working on mental maths and problem solving strategies.

## Social Studies

We will be linking our social studies learning with our stage topic to begin the year. We are creating a garden which is suitable for learning and socialising.

## H&W

We will be working on our Rights to begin the year. Our Class Charter will encourage us to be respectful of the rights of others.

Our garden topic also has many links to several Health and Wellbeing experiences and outcomes.

## Science

Through our gardening topic we will be investigating different science aspects including the medicinal and culinary uses of herbs.

## Expressive Arts

Our Drama and Art will be linked to our class novel, *"Charlotte's Web"* and the 'Garden Topic'. Miss Pinkerton will be teaching the children Drama and Miss Primrose will be teaching Art.

## RME

The children will create their own 'Personal Passport' which will reflect their values and opinions which are important to them. We will also looking at the different ways people celebrate Christmas.
