Google Classroom

Our staff have been learning about Google Classroom to support homework and learning at home if a child/ family need to isolate.

Each week a class focus will be posted informing children and families of the main areas to learn that week.

Spelling words will be in the classwork section for each group.

Instructions for tasks will also be in the classwork section.

If a child or parent wishes to message the teacher they may do so, but please remember that you will only get a response 3-4pm, Monday- Friday when a teacher is not class committed.

If you wish to upload a picture of your work you can do so by taking a photograph of the work and uploading it to the classwork section. This means that only the teacher will see your work. If you upload the photograph to the class stream, all users can see it.

Work does not need to be printed out and can be done in a jotter and returned to school as required.

If a child is isolating there will be learning grids assigned to the child for parents/carers to select as much or a little work is appropriate. We do not wish to overload parents/ carers who may be working from home or indeed unwell themselves.

If a child is unwell, we do not expect them to complete work at home.
